WATER/SEWER REPORT

Allow me to open my report with a statement of gratitude to those individuals who have expressed the confidence and support to have facilitated the placement of myself in the position of acting member at large for water and sewer maintenance. I wish to emphasize that I begin this task with a higher level of enthusiasm for the completion of the duties required than actual knowledge of the systems in place at the club. This being said I am reaching out to such individuals who possess said knowledge to guide me along as I begin this task. Perhaps it is, at this time, appropriate to share my concerns over the fact that the club, and myself in particular, have lost a substantial base of knowledge concerning water maintenance with the recent departure of a member of long standing. I know that when I initially indicated my intentions to put my name forward it was greatly based on the understanding that I would be able to draw on the support of this individual and I believe this loss has placed me in a position of disadvantage. However, I am willing to soldier along and I have no doubt that over the term of the next thirteen months, if given the opportunity through election at the AGM, I will acquire the knowledge to maintain, and perhaps improve, the levels of performance presently experienced with these systems. The water system within the pump house has been monitored for the most part almost daily and, from the feedback I have received, is functioning well. In my discussions so far it has been established that, weather permitting, we are on schedule to complete removal of the in-water piping system on October 20th. at which time the water will be shut off. Over the next few ensuing days tasks will be performed to ensure the system is properly winterized as required.

In closing, I wish to emphasize the fact that I would strongly encourage the submissions of suggestions from the membership at large to be presented for consideration at the MC level which will enhance the performance of the water and sewer systems at the club.
