

SPM 2022 M@L Water Report

As I am sure there is an extensive amount of items to be dealt with throughout the course of this meeting I will keep my report brief and to the point.

As indicated in my previous reports I am quite new in this position but am attempting to fulfil the responsibilities as required. I am pleased to say that the water system for the club was recommissioned over the course of a forty-eight hour period to be operational for the club house work party on April 23. The system was “shocked” on the 24th and samples were delivered for testing. It was established that the water is potable and achieved the required standards to qualify as such. I cannot emphasise sufficiently that the completion of the aforementioned tasks was achieved with the support of other members, who although remaining unnamed know who they are, and I wish to express my gratitude at this time for their support.

In another respect I wish to mention that a good deal of time and effort was expended on repairing and restoring of the clubhouse infrastructure which I have been informed has been an ongoing issue in the past. I plan on presenting a proposal to the MC that this issue be researched to facilitate the replacement of the outdated copper piping with a more practical PEX type structure.

In closing, I request that issues concerning the water/sewer system be brought to my attention promptly as dealing with these issues as required can not only result in avoiding further deterioration of the systems but possibly can also result in potential safety issues.
